Beefmaster Breeders United (BBU), will once again sponsor a commercial replacement female sale on April 25, 2010 in Columbus, Texas. BBU is hoping to offer 300 to 500 head of top-end E6 females in this sale. Please review the following guidelines, and if you would like to participate, and are willing to hold back some of your best E6 Females for this event, please contact our office as soon as possible. **We need to know.**

GUIDELINES:

Any E6 member is eligible to consign.

Only females certified in BBU's Certified Commercial E6 Female Program are eligible to sell, or her progeny if the owner has E6 Females consigned.

We prefer mostly pairs and bred heifers and reserve the right to limit the total number of open heifers.

A minimum age of 12 months by sale date has been set. Females up to 48 months will be accepted if they have their second calf at side. Females must be safe in calf by 24 months.

The females will be judged prior to the sale. Only pens of 5 or more head will be judged. Smaller groups will be accepted in the sale, but will not compete for prizes. Cattle will be judged in three categories – Pairs – Bred – Open.

All cattle must be certified for the E6 program according to BBU's E6 guidelines. All cattle will be screened by the BBU staff or the sales management prior to the sale and subject to inspection again upon arrival at the sale.

All cattle must meet Brucellosis and TB requirements. Texas is now a TB Free State.

Health: Every consignor regardless of point of origin must comply with the applicable rules and regulations of the Texas Animal Health Commission (TAHC). Upon arrival at the sale site, the cattle must be accompanied by an official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued by an accredited veterinarian. All females, regardless of origin and/or test status, must be Official Brucellosis Calftood Vaccinated.

Pregnancy: All females, regardless of exposure status or age, must be palpated by an accredited veterinarian and the results must be listed on the accompanying health papers.

Open Females must be declared to be open and to be satisfactory potential breeders by an accredited veterinarian and so stated on the accompanying health papers.

Consignors will be responsible for feeding, watering, and caring for their own livestock. All guarantees of any nature shall be between buyer and seller and shall not in any way bind Beefmaster Breeders United (BBU) their officers or directors, staff, employees, agents or representatives, or the Sales Management.

Neither Columbus Livestock Co., Inc., Beefmaster Breeders United(BBU), their officers or directors, staff, employees, agents or representatives, or the Sale Management will provide insurance covering any or all liability arising from any accident, injury or death incurred by or to any animal(s) consigned to this sale.

If you will consign to this sale, please fill out the enclosed nomination form and send or fax it to my office as soon as possible. **It may seem early, but we need to know the numbers we will have for budgeting purposes.**
