This will be a BBU Approved Sale.

There is a \$50 consignment fee per lot. If your lot sells through the sale, one-half of the fee will be refunded to you and the other half will be applied towards prize money for the Perfect Pair Futurity. If you do not bring the animal to the sale, or the animal is removed from the sale by the BBU Fieldman or Sale Management the fee will be forfeited and applied towards sale expenses.

Nomination Deadline is March 17, 2010. Consignors will be limited to 4 lots. A maximum of 70 lots will be accepted. We are looking for high quality, traditional cattle. If we do not have 70 lots consigned by the nomination date of March 17, 2010, we will accept more than four lots per consignor. Consign early!

Nomination must consist of: Signed nomination form along with nomination fee and Original Breeding Certificate on each animal. If you need to apply for calf papers, please send the application to the attention of Marie Zirkle and head the application with the “*Southmost Sale, May 1, 2010*” to the BBU office in San Antonio. If you have any questions, please give my office a call.

Catalog information: Footnotes for the catalog are optional; however, we urge you to send any pertinent data you have on each animal, especially weights and measures information and calving records.

Every animal must be of excellent quality and in excellent condition. The Sale Manager recommends that all cattle consigned be of 2 quality or better. All cattle will be graded by committee and will sell in graded order. Consign your best!

GUIDELINES FOR CATTLE CONSIGNED:

BULLS: 18 months to 48 months of age maximum. Maximum of 20 bulls accepted. All bulls must be fertility tested and have scrotal circumference in centimeters within 30 days prior to sale date and this information must appear on the health paper. **BBU requires that all bulls 18 months of age and older must pass a Breeding Soundness Evaluation (BSE). This report can be on the form provided by the BBU office or the official form by the Society of Theriogenology and attached to the health papers required for the sale. All bulls must be Trich tested in order to sell.**

The Perfect Pair Futurity: All pairs and 3n1's will compete in a Futurity to be judged by a panel of judges. The premium fee for this competition will be \$25 per lot with added money from outside sponsors. Prize money will be awarded in both categories and all cattle will sell in the order they are placed. Please consider this as a challenge and consign your very best.

THREE-IN-ONES OR PAIRS: Age limit up to 96 months of age (8 years). Any female over 36 months of age must sell with natural calf at side. Any female with a calf at side that is six months of age or older, must be palpated safe in calf by a licensed vet and this information must appear on the health paper.

BRED AND EXPOSED: Up to 36 months of age. Any heifer over 24 months of age must be palpated safe in calf by a licensed vet and this information must appear on the health paper.

OPEN: 13 to 24 months of age. We recommend that open heifers be no older than 18 months of age. These heifers will be guaranteed open and certified by a licensed vet and so stated on the health paper. We will accept 15 females for this category.

SPECIAL LOTS: Any donor selling must abide by the rules of a BBU Approved Sale.

HEALTH PAPERS:

A separate health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian is required on each lot consigned with all required information appearing thereon:

1. All cattle of age must be Brucellosis tested unless you are a Certified Free Herd.
2. Texas is now a TB Free State
3. BSE & Semen test on each bull as stipulated above with scrotal circumference.
4. Palpation on each female.
5. All cattle must carry an Interstate Health Certificate.
6. All bulls must be Trich Tested.
7. Have your vet check all eligible females to be sure they are Calvhod Vaccinated.

If the females you have consigned are Calvhod Vaccinated for Brucellosis, this information must be stated on your health papers. Testing must be done within 30 days of Sale Date. We recommend all health papers have an issue date within 10 days of sale date. Health certificates must meet the standard of both state and federal requirements and must accompany all cattle upon delivery at the sale site. Any animal not meeting all the above listed requirements or any animal not of outstanding quality and in acceptable sale condition will be sifted and not allowed to sell.

Note: If you need assistance in selecting cattle for the sale, it is available for a cost of \$100 per ranch visit. Please include the fee with your nomination form. Do not delay. This must be scheduled early.
